

Instructions for Submitting a Dissertation in Electronic Format to the Zentralbibliothek Zürich

The Zentralbibliothek Zürich offers doctoral candidates at the University of Zürich, in accordance with the faculty department rules of the University regarding graduation, the possibility of submitting their dissertation in electronic format. The dissertation will be listed in the library catalog of the Zentralbibliothek Zürich.

Procedures

- Faculties and degree candidates of the University of Zürich are hereby advised of the possibility of submitting dissertations in electronic form.
- Candidates are expected to prepare the electronic version independently (institutes and faculty departments, as well as the Centre for Information Services of the University of Zürich, can provide assistance), following the *instruction sheet* → [Technical Instructions for Preparing a Dissertation in Electronic Format](#).
- Candidates are responsible for copyright clearance in connection with the publication of their dissertation and will be obliged to sign a *statement of agreement* → [Declaration of Consent upon Submission of a Dissertation in Electronic Format to the Zentralbibliothek Zürich](#).
- Submission of an electronic dissertation requires one CD-ROM with the data described in the *instruction sheet* → [Technical Instructions for Preparing a Dissertation in Electronic Format](#), *along* with four printed deposit copies (not including any additional copies demanded by the faculty).
- The minimum requirements for the printed version of an electronic dissertation are contained in a University of Zürich *instruction sheet* and must be followed → [Minimum Requirements for the Printed Version of a Dissertation in Electronic Format](#).
- The Zentralbibliothek Zürich will list the dissertation in its library catalog. The catalog entry refers to the PDF-version according to the *instruction sheet* → [Technical Instructions for Preparing a Dissertation in Electronic Format](#).
