

## Minimum Requirements for the Printed Version of a Dissertation in Electronic Format

The Zentralbibliothek Zürich offers doctoral candidates at the University of Zürich, in accordance with the faculty department rules of the University regarding graduation, the possibility of submitting their dissertation in electronic format. The minimum requirements for the printed version of a dissertation in electronic format, which have been established by the University of Zürich after consultation with the various faculties, are as follows:

1. The complete text must be printed, including illustrations in a reasonable resolution. Raw data, codes, etc. essential only to computer processing should not be printed.
2. Whenever appropriate, the references should explicitly name their destination (URL links to external documents must be colour-backed and visible as such in the printed version).
3. The dissertation must be printed on non-ageing paper and so bound that it can be stored in the library archives.
