Abstract

Knowledge of forest change type and timing is required for forest management, reporting, and science. Time series of historic satellite data (e.g. Landsat) have resulted in an invaluable record of changes in forest conditions. Natural resource management and reporting typically operate at an annual time step, yet the recent addition of data streams from compatible satellites (e.g., Sentinel-2) offer the possibility of generating frequent, management relevant forest status assessments.
